Total Allocation: \$139,807

Requirement #1 20% for evidence based learning loss intervention (\$27,961.40)

The Janesville CSD is allocating this portion of ESSER III funding for the operation of summer school program over the next two years. Over the summer of 2021 we spent \$16,600 to staff and support the summer work. We anticipate that we will spend a similar amount in the summer of 2022.

The Janesville CSD summer school program was offered to 48 students in grades K-3 that were identified using FAST scores, district level assessments, and teacher recommendations. Forty students attended regularly for both daily math and literacy instruction for 5 weeks.

An additional summer school cost is the cost of transportation. We spent \$2,192 on transporting the 40 summer school students to and from school.
